STUDIO INFORMATION AND POLICIES

Thank you for being a part of our In2YouArts Family!!

REGISTRATION FEE

A registration fee is required with the registration form to reserve class space. **Registration will not be considered complete and class space not reserved until this fee has been paid.** Registration is \$25 for new families and \$15 for returning families. Registration may be paid with cash or check. You may opt to pay registration fee with first monthly payment.

TUITION/PAYMENT

*If you wish to pay tuition in full, this payment unfortunately is **non-refundable**. *If we have a repeat of studio closure due to COVID-19 etc, payments in full will be non-refundable, HOWEVER, you may use it as a credit towards future classes.

*All tuition is required to be on automatic payment. Please fill out attached form.

*A reminder email will be sent the beginning of every month. If any information needs to be changed, please do so before your scheduled payment date.

*If a card is declined, you have 14 days to supply a new card to be processed. A \$10 late fee will be applied if no new payment has been made in the 14 days. If no payment has been made, attendance to classes will be suspended until amount is paid.

*Tuition remains the same regardless of absences and whether it is a long, five-week month or a short, two-week month. The class fee is for a full session (Sept through May) divided into 9 installments. **It is not a monthly fee.** A session fee is for 30 weeks, however we schedule 32 classes to account for any weather related cancellations. Any weather related days off more than the 2 built in, you will be able to come in at your convenience to take any of our classes as a make-up or zoom into a class. We do NOT prorate for weather related days off or sick days.

CLASS CHANGES

When dropping or adding a class at any time during the year, the front desk must be notified. Forms will be available at front desk and must be signed by a parent. *Not showing up for classes, does not constitute a withdrawal from class. Accounts will continue to be charged for tuition as well as any costumes we believe needed until the drop-add form has been completed.* This is very important for attendance and costume ordering purposes. **All class changes must be made by November 1st due to costume ordering – NO EXCEPTIONS.** This ensures that we order the proper costumes for each class/student.

If a class is switched without notice, there may not be a costume available. Please make sure the front desk is aware of any class changes. Please note: if the front desk has not been notified of a class change and costumes have been ordered, we cannot issue refunds or return the costume.

BAD WEATHER / HOLIDAYS

The studio follows Stroudsburg School District for School/studio closings. However, an official decision on evening classes will always be made by 2pm that day. Two-hour delays will result in studio opening at 10am for morning classes. Please see attached calendar for our holidays/days off. We **do not prorate** for snow days missed. If there are any snow days in additional to the 2 accounted for, we allow you to take a makeup class at your convenience.

ATTENDANCE

Good attendance is imperative, as absences and tardiness can hold back an entire class. Students should be prompt and prepared for class. If you are more than 15 minutes late to class, you may be

asked to sit out of class. If you miss more than 3 consecutive classes, you may be asked to understudy the piece for recital. Students may also be asked to sit out of class if not in proper dance attire (see below).

ILLNESS/SICKNESS

As a courtesy to other students, families, & our staff, students who are ill should not be in class. Please do not send students to classes until they have been fever/symptom free for at least 24 hours. There are lots of germs around and we would like to keep our students, families, & staff as healthy as possible! Students may observe classes if they are working through an injury but should not be observing classes if they are sick. If they are unable to make the class, but would like to zoom in that week please let us know. *Please see our COVID-19 Safety Guidelines

COSTUMES(Musical Theater)

We are excited every year to have Musical Theater students participate in the FuSia Dancefest Year End Recital in May. Costumes prices are as follows: All classes are \$65 each except for Level 3 and 4 Tap & all Contemporary classes – they are \$30 each. Please ask us about male costume pricing. Payments are due in full by November 21st for costume to be ordered. Please see front desk for pricing/payment options. Be aware that if our recital has to be cancelled due to closures such as COVID-19, we would not be able to refund the costume amount once costumes have been received. Please know that the recital is not mandatory.

Costumes take a few months to be delivered, which is why it is imperative for payment to be made promptly by November. *We cannot guarantee delivery of costume by picture week or recital if not paid by the due date.***

DRESS CODE (Musical Theater)

We have a dress code for all students except for our Music Together, Dance Basics/Hip Hop Tots/Acro Adventure/Creative Dance students. Students must wear comfortable form-fitting dance attire to display proper body alignment and allow for easy movement. ***No jeans, jewelry or any inappropriate attire will be allowed.*** Hair should always be securely pulled away from the face. Teachers reserve the right to sit students out of class if not properly dressed.

- ☐ **MUSICAL THEATER**– solid colored tops, leotards, black leggings or shorts and tap/jazz shoes.

MERCHANDISE: FuSia Dance sells Bloch merchandise and shoes. They do keep some sizes in stock, but please note that most shoes/attire will need to be order as needed. All Bloch merchandise is cash/check.

STUDIO RULES -

- Students should be dressed and prepared for before entering the building. No changing allowed in the bathrooms.
- Our waiting room is closed to families until further notice. The only exception is for our younger classes: Music Together, Creative Dance, Dance Basics, Hip Hop Tots, and Acro Adventure. Only ONE parent/guardian allowed per family. Those entering in the waiting room must wear a mask at all times and adhere to the 6ft social distancing guidelines.
- No street shoes should be worn in the studios. Please change into dance shoes before class. All belongings will be kept in the classroom.
- Chewing gum is never allowed in the dance studios.
- ***Always*** treat your teacher and fellow classmates with respect. This includes inappropriate language.
- NO cell phones allowed in classrooms. Unless there is an emergency, students may contact parents between classes. If using cell phones during break time, no students can photograph or video tape other students without their permission. This is especially important for the safety of all students. Also, please talk with your students about what they are posting on social media. Inappropriate posts pertaining to other students or the studio will result in their release from our studio. Absolutely no posting of any choreography in studio material (less than 30 seconds is permitted).
- **PARKING LOT** – It is imperative in keeping all our families safe, so please **DO NOT stop or park in front of our entrance – This is considered a fire hazard!** Also, there is no smoking allowed in our building or parking lot. Thank you in advance for your cooperation. If you are dropping student(s) off please pull down the parking lot or pull into a space.

COMMUNICATION

As with any good relationship, we believe communication is important to have productive and happy families! We have monthly newsletters sent home as well as emailed to you. If you are not receiving a newsletter from your student, please let us know. Our biggest form of communication at the studio is email. If you do not have an email, please let us know so we can make arrangements to get you the

information that you need. We send emails almost weekly if not more. If you are not receiving emails from us please check your spam folder and if not, let us know so we can make sure we have the correct email on file. We will be using BandApp for most of our communication during the year as well as email. Please search for “**In2YouArts**” on Band App to join –This will allow you to access newsletters, calendar, and other pertinent information. We also have a Facebook page and we are on Instagram. DANCE PICTURES(Musical Theater)

As a courtesy to all our families, we have a week in the spring dedicated to pictures in their recital costumes. This is not mandatory.

2020-2021 In2YouArts Artsfest

Our Annual Artsfest is scheduled for the 1st weekend of May. May 7th, 8th & 9th! We will have all students in our Acting, Private Lesson, and Visual Art Programs present work and or perform. We will send out sign ups for any student interested in performing or presenting work. This will be held throughout our Studio at FuSia Center for the Arts.

2020-2021 FUSIA DANCEFEST(Musical Theater)

Our Year End recital is May 22 & 23 at the Notre Dame High School Theater. Recital information will be sent home in October with costume information. Your recital day/time is listed on the fall schedule to assist you in picking classes. Dress rehearsal schedule will be available in April. Our recital is not mandatory. Just let the teachers and desk staff know if you do not wish to participate by November. We do have backstage mothers to help out. We have signups in March and allow a limited amount of parents per room. You must have PA state clearances to be a backstage mom. Please be aware that when you will receive a pass for your student when you bring them to the recital. This pass will be used to retrieve your child at the end of recital. For the safety of your child(ren) and all our other students, all students must stay in the backstage/classroom area with their designated stage mom until they are released to your care at the end of the show. Our year end recital is contingent on what is allowed for our county at that time for performances due to COVID-19.

ZOOM

We are happy to be able to offer the option of Zoom classes this year for those families that are not comfortable with in person classes. An email will be sent to any students signed up for Zoom only option at the start of our fall session with any information needed. **IMPORTANT: Photographs or videos are not allowed to be taken during our zoom classes. This is a privacy safety measure for all our families. Not all families agree to allow their children's picture to be used in our advertising or social media so please be mindful of all our In2YouArts family's privacy.**

COVID-19 POLICIES

- The waiting room is closed until further notice. If parents need to come for paperwork, payments, etc. please make an appointment during your child's class time.
- Students will have their temperatures checked upon entering the building. Any student with a temperature of 100 degrees or higher will not be permitted in for class. We ask that parents play an important role in keeping track of their child(ren)'s health. If your child isn't feeling well or you know that they have a fever, please keep them home. If we feel a student is exhibiting any symptoms of being sick we will send them home.
- We ask that students be dropped off no earlier than 5 minutes before class time. This is to help getting everyone checked in and ready for class and having time to release our other students.
- Students need to arrive at the studio in their dance attire. There will be no changing allowed in the bathrooms or dance rooms. Due to covid-19 the first floor and lower level bathrooms will be available for students. Our third floor level is for staff only.
- Masks will be worn by all In2YouArts & FuSia staff and students that are **5 yrs and older**. We do have FuSia Center for the Arts masks for sale if needed at the front desk. Students must wear their masks while in the waiting room and while dancing. Teachers will give breaks throughout class while social distancing to have “mask break” to have some water. We encourage all students to bring in their own water bottle from home.
- Our class sizes are 10 max for the young classes and no more than 16 for levels 1-4.
- All classrooms are equipped with 6ft dance squares for the children to dance in. along with 6 foot perimeters around the room for across the floor exercises. All ballet barres will be off limits until further notice. All acro equipment will be sanitized after every class. As well as touchless hand sanitizers which are also located throughout the waiting room. Classes are scheduled with 15 min breaks in between to allow for cleaning and sanitizing of floors, door handles, mats, class props and chairs. We will also deep clean nightly after hours.

- With the exception of shoes, our lost and found will be removed. Please remind your student to take ALL belongings with them at the end of the class. Items left unclaimed at the studio more than 24 hours will be thrown away.
- Any student not following these guidelines will be asked to leave the building for the safety of all.

Private Lessons:

We are making studio C upstairs safe and within COVID guidelines to offer lessons in the studio. We know that many Vocal students benefit from coming into the space and some have already said they would like to rather than zoom in. We also will look at the daytime schedule of the dance studio B which has a piano available for in house lessons as well. Here are the requirements for lessons in the studio

- Vocal students must wear a face shield, all others not singing simply wear a mask
- Staff must remain by the piano and wear their mask.
- Staff must only stay in the room and bring all food, water, etc with them. And use the upstairs bathroom only.
- Lessons must be sanitized in between. Therefore all lessons will be 45 minutes apart not 30 minutes to allow time to clean in between.
- We will encourage the students coming into the lesson to wait by the bottom of the steps until the student previous to them has left and exited.
- The teacher will simply call down to their student to come upstairs.
